It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 31-23.2-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-23 entitled
2 "Registry of motor vehicles - Odometer inspection" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3 31-23.2-10 Registry of motor vehicles - Odometer inspection. - Notwithstanding any
4 other provisions of the general laws, the registry of motor vehicles shall require the
5 inspection by a member of a city or town police department, of the odometer of every
6 motor vehicle purchased from a seller from outside the state of Rhode Island prior to
7 issuing a certificate of title in accordance with the provisions of §31-23.2-6.
8 For each vehicle inspected, the local police department may collect a fee of ten
9 ~~dollars (\$10.00)~~ twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
