ESTABLISHING THE CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE,
APPROVED AUGUST 7, 1953.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Classification Plan as incorporated and adopted in Section 1 of the Ordinance, Chapter 760, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing a Classification Plan for the City of Providence", as amended is hereby further amended in the following respect:

Add: One (1) Mayor's Police Aide

SECTION 2. There shall be established within the Police Department, the position of a Mayor's Police Aide; said Mayor's Police Aide shall be detached from the Police Department to the Mayor's Office with full police powers to serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Said Mayor's Police Aide, once assigned to the Executive Office, will hold the ~~temporary~~ rank of Lieutenant in the Providence Police Department and shall receive the appropriate compensation as per Chapter 70-28 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence. ^{v.b.} 10-1-70

IF and when said Mayor's Police Aide is reassigned from the Mayor's Office to the Providence Police Department, he will resume his last highest permanent rank with the appropriate compensation for that rank.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
