WHEREAS, The present method of appointments of Members of the School Committee, by the Mayor, appears to leave certain areas of the City without local representation, and

WHEREAS, Although the present Mayor appointed School Committee authorized the City of Providence, via voter referendum, it further appears that method is somewhat archaic and a question should be submitted to referendum,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Acting City Solicitor is hereby requested, caused to be introduced, at the January 1978 Session of the General Assembly an Act Placing on the Ballot at the 1978 General Election for the Voters of the City of Providence to decide the question of permitting an Elected School Committee.
