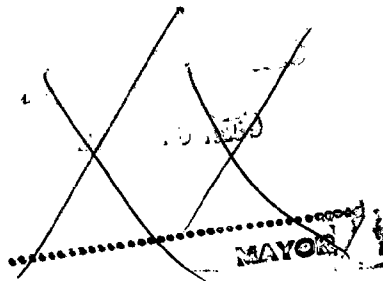

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, September 26, 1961.

This referral is a request for study, report and recommendation concerning the proposed change of zoning from an R-4 Zone to an M-1 Zone of Lot 32 on Assessor's Plat 29, said lot being situated on the northeasterly corner of Knight Street and Washington Street. The area in question contains 4,341 square feet of land.


It was determined on an inspection and photographic survey that the parcel of land in question contained two vacant 2½-story frame dwelling units.

There is extensive spot zoning already evident in this area and any further spot zoning as requested in this petition would only increase the haphazard zoning in this area thus decrease surrounding residential property values. Therefore,
