WHEREAS, this outstanding act of bravery and compassion serves as a source of inspiration to us all,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the Providence City Council hereby commend Patrolman Edwin T. Scallon for his heroic efforts in saving the life of twenty-two month old Michael Carter.
