
Approved May 21, 2002

RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to prohibit motor vehicle traffic along various streets located in the First Ward on various dates and times to accommodate Brown University.

Friday, May 17, 2002 to Saturday, May 18, 2002

Wriston/Kenney Quad Areas:

1. George Street one-way east from Brown Street to Thayer Street
2. Charlesfield Street one-way west from Thayer Street to Brown Street
3. Benevolent Street one-way east from Magee Street to Brown Street
4. Brown Street one-way north from Charlesfield Street to George Street
5. Post and enforce "NO PARKING/EMERGENCY TOW ZONE" on the west side of Magee Street from George Street to Benevolent Street.

Dear Ms. Testa:

The end of the school year will see students moving out of their dormitories on Friday, May 17 and Saturday, May 18, 2002. With the majority of students leaving on Saturday, I am requesting approval for the following traffic pattern and posting on these dates to deal with congestion around the University area:

Wriston/Kcency Quad Areas:

1. George Street one-way east from Brown Street to Thayer Street
2. Charlesfield Street one-way west from Thayer to Brown Street
3. Benevolent Street one-way east from Magee to Brown Street
4. Brown Street one-way north from Charlesfield to George Street
5. Post and enforce "NO PARKING/EMERGENCY TOW ZONE" on the west side of Magee Street from George to Benevolent St.

This traffic pattern should be established by 0600 on Friday, May 17 and end by 1500 on Saturday, May 18, 2002. In addition, we are requesting that Providence Police relax tagging on these days in the University area. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
