RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of "No Parking" signs along Kenyon Street, between America Street and DePasquale Avenue.

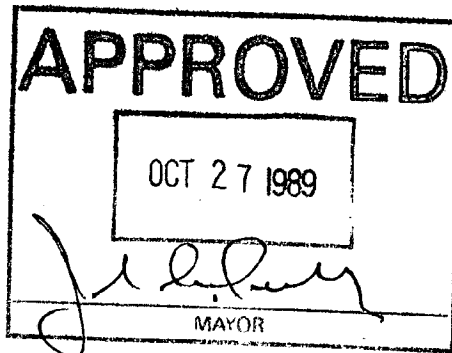

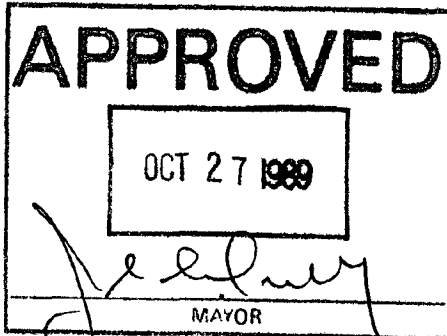


Dear Ms. Mendonca:

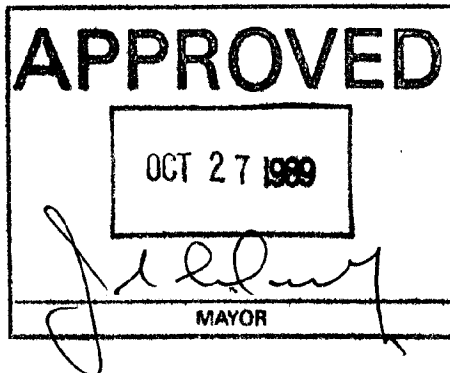
