

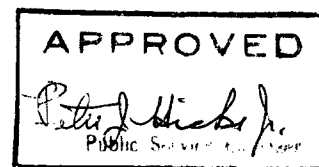

SUBJECT: Referral No. 875 - ZONING CHANGE AT 118 LABAN STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, February 26, 1957.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-2 Zone to a C-1 Zone, Lot 324 on Assessor's Plat 107 located on the southerly side of Laban Street, 118 Laban Street. The area in question contains 5,000 square feet of land area.


On the field trip it was found that the area in question is occupied by a three-family dwelling and is surrounded by exclusively residential properties.

The granting of this petition would create a commercial use in a residential zone, creating a new case of spot zoning which would adversely affect the immediately adjoining and surrounding residential properties. Therefore, in view of the fact that adequate commercial zoning exists in close proximity, specifically at Plainfield Street,
