

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 175

Approved April 13, 1980

WHEREAS, Senator Claiborne Pell has introduced Senate Bill S-1962 in amendment to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, thereby increasing Rhode Island's share of federal funding under this program by as much as Twenty-two Million Dollars (\$22,000,000.00) yearly for wastewater treatment programs, and

WHEREAS, This increase would be as a result of the Federal Government changing its appropriation formula to reflect the very serious regional need for this increased appropriation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence gives its wholehearted support and urges speedy passage of Senate Bill S-1962 and recommend to the Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works that they give thorough and speedy passage to this much needed Bill.
