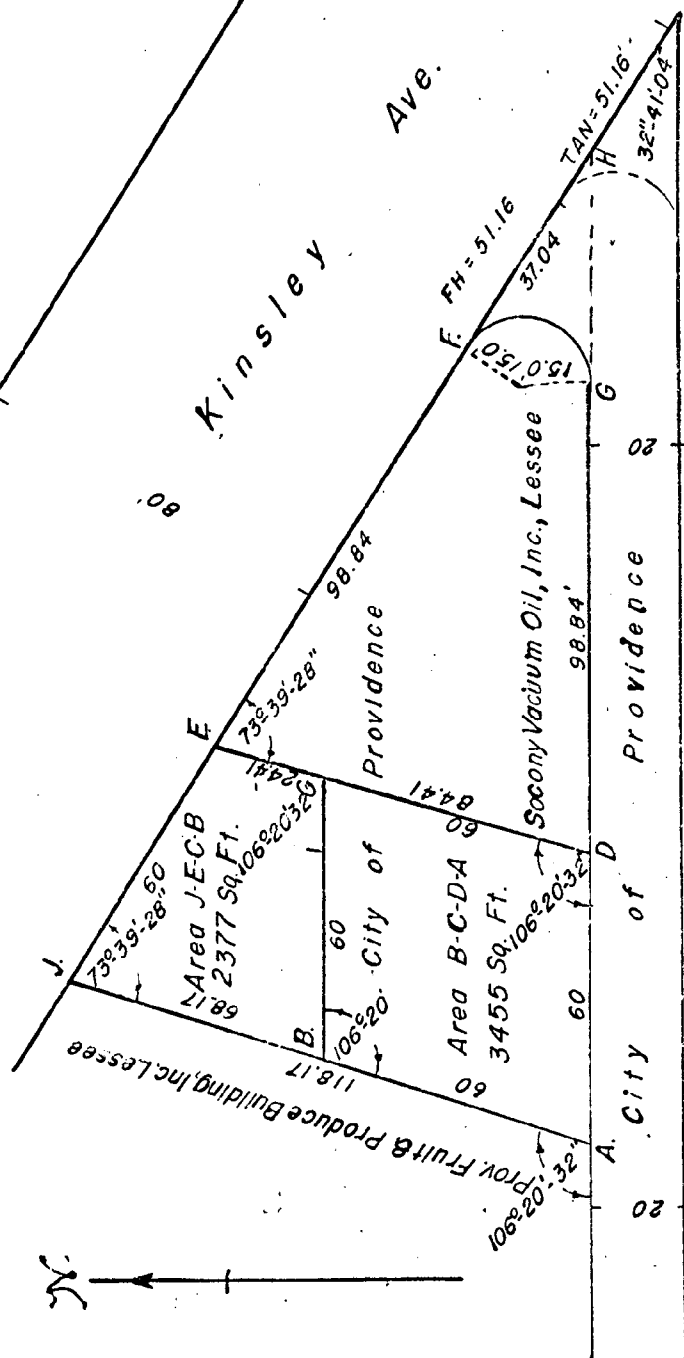

On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that Lot 344 on Assessor's Plat 26 contains a one-story diner and parking area for same.


The lot is zoned M-1 (general industrial). The surrounding area is industrial and commercial in character and in fair condition.

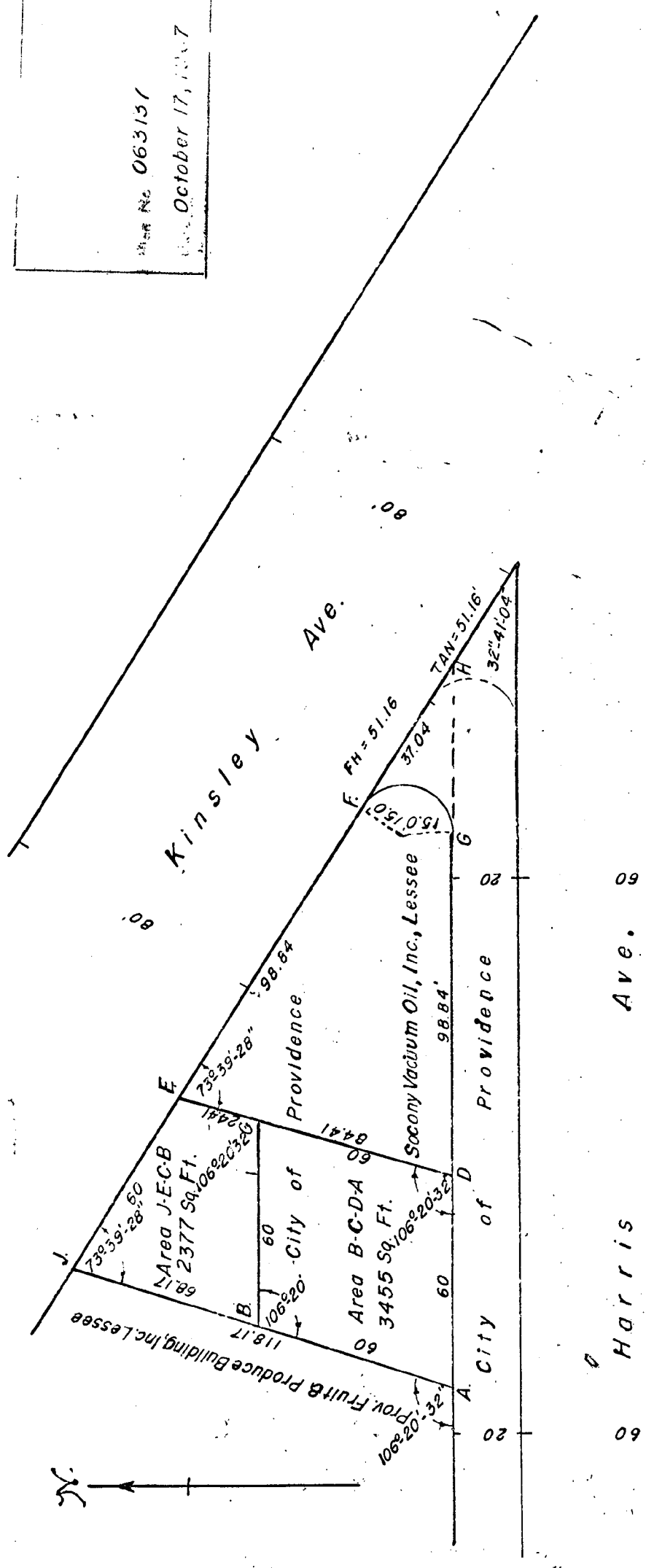
