No. 334 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 17-28 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED "ASSIGNMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS TO CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS"

*Approved* July 3, 1990

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Assignment of Police Officers to Construction Project. The Chief of Police, or his designee, shall have the power and authority to assign police officers to any road construction projects or any other assignment at the request of any person, business or corporation within the City of Providence when it is determined by him that such an assignment is necessary for the public safety.

The officers so assigned will be paid for such duty by the contractor in accordance with the schedule of charges in effect by the City of Providence. Further, the contractor shall, in addition, be responsible to pay to the City of Providence, any administrative charges directly related to the expenses incurred by the City of Providence in providing the officer to the contractor.

SECTION 2. If any clause or portion of this Ordinance shall be deemed unconstitutional, it shall not affect any other portion or clause of the Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
