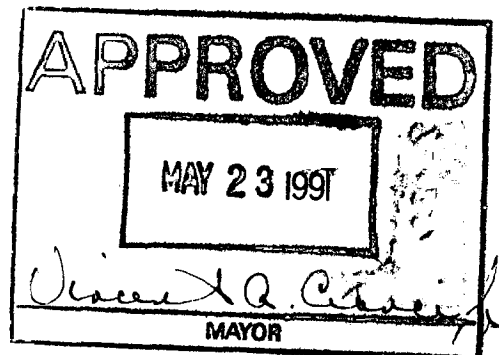

Dispositon: Four way stop controls are hereby denied at the above listed intersecitons. The City Solicitor's Department has advised this department that requests for four-way stop signs should be solely determined on their meeting Federal (and State) warrants in order to minimize liability to the City for both maintenance and improper approval of four-way stop requests. The above listed intersections do not meet the minimum requirements as set forth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

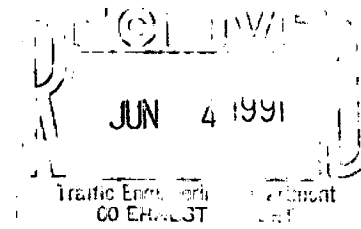
