

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 221

Approved April 15, 1977

WHEREAS, recently Policewoman Nancy S. Kerrigan and Policewoman Judith H. Mirando, under the supervision of Inspector of Narcotics Malcolm T. Brown and Sergeant Edward F. Pike of the Providence Police Narcotics Squad were directly responsible for the closing of Geiro's Pizza, 182-184 Angell Street, Providence, which was described as a gathering place for juveniles, where drugs were dispensed on the premises, and

WHEREAS, in pursuing the implicit instructions of their superiors, our dedicated Policewomen conducted their undercover assignments in a most efficient manner, to the end that the necessary evidence was procured and the guilty were apprehended.
