RE: TRANSMITTAL OF COMMUNICATION TO COMMITTEE

REQUEST: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a blinking light at the intersection of Butler Avenue and Blackstone Boulevard at the Lincoln School.

DISPOSITION: The Department of Traffic Engineering does not have the funding at this time for the installation of flashing lights. The cost would be approximately \$7,000 for a basic unit. There are a number of schools in Providence where flashing beacons are necessary. This department will request monies in the upcoming budget year for the beginning of a program to signalize a number of schools each year. As you know, the City of Providence has many intersections that require fully signalized intersections and the City does not have the funds available at this time.
