SUBJECT: Referral No. 1703 - ABANDONMENT OF PREMISES LOCATED ALONG TINGLEY STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Monday, November 18, 1968.

This referral is a request to abandon a parcel of land of approximately 50' x 200' located as follows: from the northwest corner of Lot 234 on Assessor's Plat 26 along the lot line in a generally southerly direction for approximately 200 feet to Harris Avenue; thence along the northerly line of Harris Avenue in a generally easterly direction for approximately 50 feet; thence in a line parallel to the westerly lot line back to the northerly lot line at Tingley Street; and westerly to the point of beginning. This parcel was once known as a portion of Mary Street (reference - Plat book 4, Page 31 dated 1864 in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the City of Providence). This land is now part of Lot 234, Assessor's Plat 26, and the owner of record, according to the Tax Assessor's office is: Arrow Transportation Co., Inc., 288 Kinsley Avenue, Providence, R. I.

On an inspection and photographic tour it was revealed that the parcel of land in question is a roadway used by the Arrow Transportation Company and clearly marked "Private Property Keep Out!".

If it can be established that the City of Providence has some claim to this land as a public highway,


