

RESOLVED, that the Traffic Engineer prohibit both pedestrian and vehicular traffic on those portions of Seaview Drive and Harborside Boulevard delineated on the accompanying maps marked "A" and "B," respectively.


Said prohibition shall apply to all pedestrian and vehicular traffic except:

- (a) all on-duty public safety personnel and vehicles.
- (b) personnel and vehicles necessary to maintain existing public utilities.
- (c) personnel and vehicles necessary to maintain existing commercial enterprise.

Provided, however, that access under paragraphs (b) and (c) above shall be permitted only upon application, review and approval of a security plan by Providence Port Security and the Commissioner of Public Safety.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Traffic Engineer forthwith erect appropriate signage so as to effect the purposes of this Resolution.

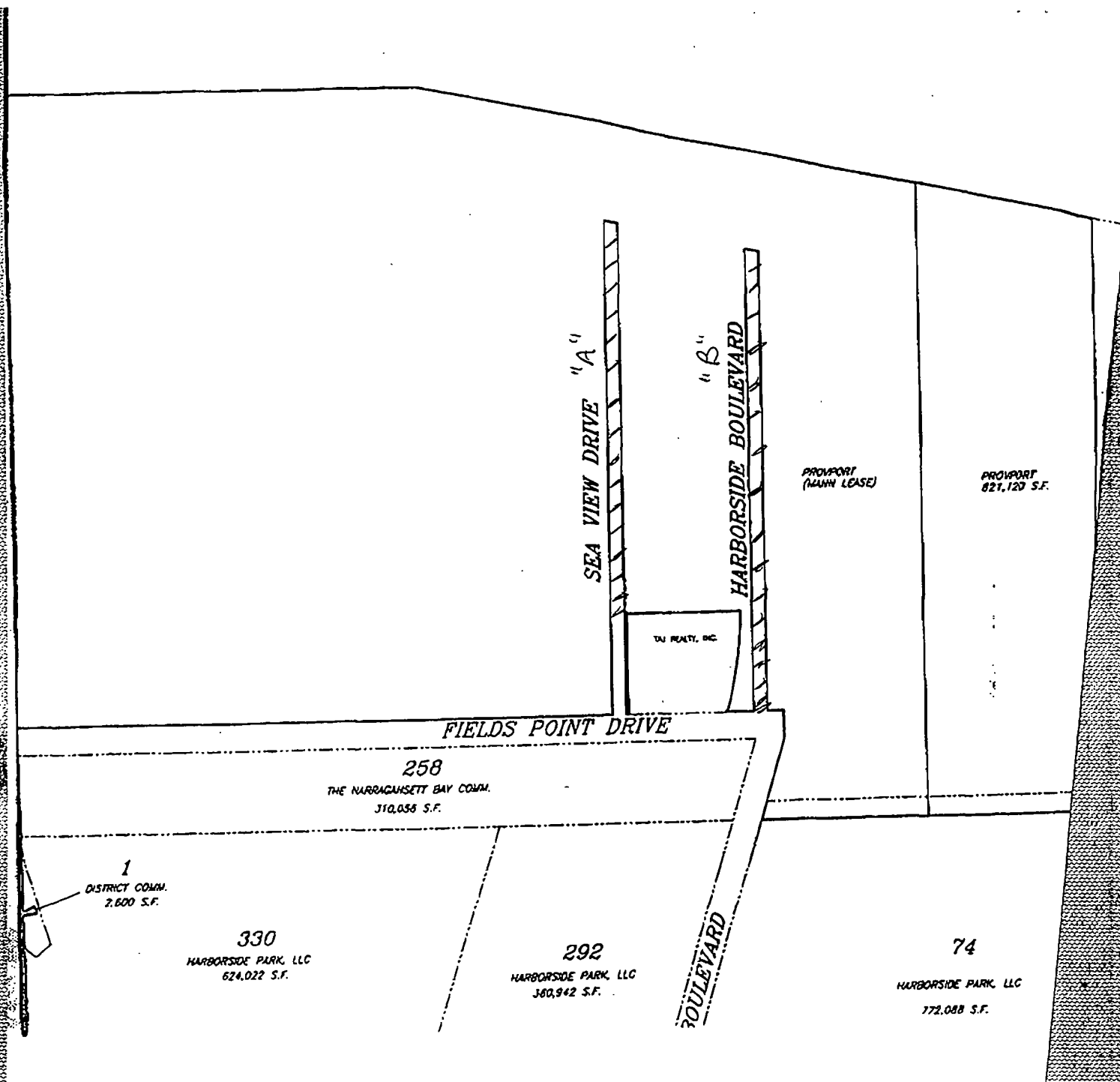
