# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 564

Approved November 28, 1989

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 064458, dated June 27, 1989",

VIZ:

Wesleyan Avenue, shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A), having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway, provided that the Department of Public Works has a full sewer easement for the twelve (12") inch combination sewer provided further for a utility-corridor easement of that portion of Wesleyan Avenue which shall be accessible to the Water Supply Board at all times in the event that they have to respond to an emergency or maintenance needs, the petitioner is responsible for preparation of the easement description which must be approved by the Water Supply Board. The easement shall be full-street width, curb to curb. No obstructions to include structures, landscaping, or other improvements shall be permitted within the easement area. The petitioner will hold the Water Supply Board free of any liability for any losses occurring to the petitioners property within the easement area if the water main or water appurtenances should fail, any fencing of the easement will exclude a gate valve and fire hydrant located on Wesleyan Avenue at Elmwood Avenue, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further,

ORDERED, That the Traffic Engineer, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the Words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

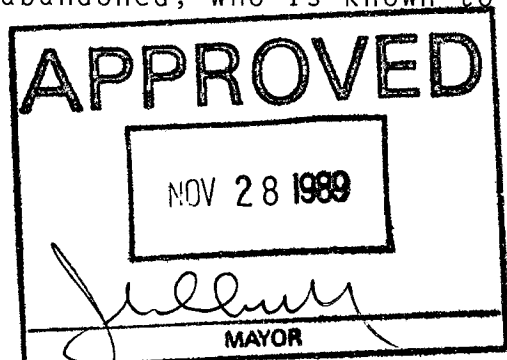

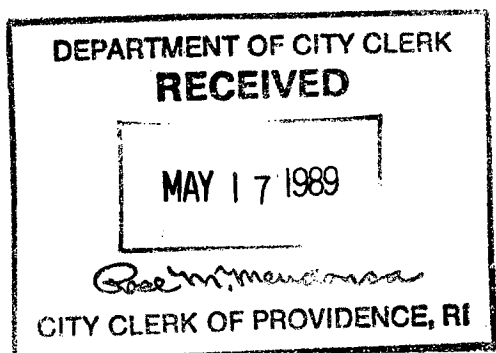

Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission at its July 18, 1989 regular monthly meeting reviewed and evaluated the proposed abandonment of the western portion of Wesleyan Avenue from the intersection with Elmwood Avenue to the easterly property line of Lot 318 on Assessor's Plat 44.

The petitioner is Mr. Jake Kaplan, President of Jake Kaplan's Ltd. on 206 Elmwood Avenue, Providence, Rhode Island. The petitioner owns all abutting lots numbered: 376, 324, 322, 323, 321, 320, 318 on the northerly side of Wesleyan Avenue and all abutting lots numbered: 276, 284, 281, 279 and 378 on the southerly side of Wesleyan Avenue.

The petitioner agrees to dedicate for highway purposes Lot 285 and a portion of Lot 595 on Assessor's Plat 44 to provide public right-of-way between Wesleyan Avenue and Plenty Street.

A field inspection revealed that the subject portion of Wesleyan Avenue is a paved public right-of-way with curbs and paved sidewalks. The abutting lots on the northerly side of the aforesaid portion of Wesleyan Avenue were developed recently as a paved parking area serving Jake Kaplan's Ltd. automobile dealership.

The adjacent residential two and three family structures located on Wesleyan Avenue on Lots 317, 316, 315 are in fair to good condition.

Referral No. 2294

The abutting lots on the southerly side of the aforesaid portion of Wesleyan Avenue together with the lots fronting Plenty Street contain a large commercial auto-service structure, a portion of which, fronting Elmwood Avenue, is under construction.

Lot 285 and 595 dedicated for a new public right-of-way are paved, fenced and used as a temporary parking area.


A number of adjacent lots east of the proposed new right-of-way and located between Wesleyan Avenue and Plenty Street are paved, fenced and used as a parking area for St. Joseph's Hospital.

The proposed abandonment in conjunction with the dedication for highway purposes of Lot 285 and 595 will serve to enhance the economic development of the area.

The Commission voted to advise the Committee on Public Works that no objection is offered to this petition subject to the following conditions:

- a) The petitioner will construct a new public right-of-way on Lots 285 and 595 at no cost to the City.
- b) The petitioner will grant all appropriate easements for utilities running along a portion of Wesleyan Avenue to be abandoned.
