It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 45-2-15 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-2 entitled "General
2 Powers" is hereby repealed.

3 ~~**45-2-15. Police officers and fire fighters.** — No city or town shall require that an~~
4 ~~individual reside within the city or town as a condition for appointment or continued employment~~
5 ~~in its police or fire department.~~

6 SECTION 2. Chapter 45-2 of the General Laws entitled "General Powers" is hereby
7 amended by adding thereto the following section:

8 **45-2-15.1. Police officers and firefighters -- Residency within municipality not**
9 **required.** — No general law, city or town ordinance or home rule charter shall require that a
10 police officer or firefighter reside within the city or town as a condition of appointment or
11 continued employment. Any prior ratification and validation by the general assembly of a home
12 rule charter provision requiring residency within a city or town as a condition for employment of
13 a police officer or firefighter is hereby repealed by the general assembly; provided, further, no
14 city or town council shall make or ordain any ordinance requiring a police officer or firefighter to
15 reside within the employing city or town as a condition of appointment or continued employment,
16 and any existing ordinance requiring a police officer or firefighter to reside within the employing
17 city or town as a condition of appointment or continued employment is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
