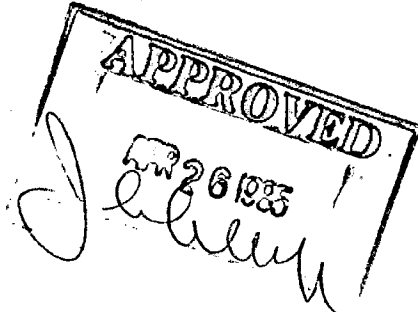

Please be advised that a defect exists on the sidewalk on Plainfield Street side of 160 Plainfield Street, Providence, R.I.

The defect consists of a couple of concrete sections that are about 4 to 6" higher than the next concrete section.

This condition is dangerous and has caused people to trip, but fortunately not injured enough to bring suit - at least not to date.
