WHEREAS, On Thursday, May 27 a fire broke out in a house on the corner of Byfield and Ocean streets was engulfed in flames and smoke coming from the third floor and attic; and

WHEREAS Providence Parks Department employees David Doti and Gary Kraus, witnessed the fire breaking out and immediately jumped into action; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Doti and Mr. Kraus rushed into the burning building, with complete disregard for their own safety, to make sure everyone in the building was able to escape the fire; and

WHEREAS, The heroic actions of Mr. Doti and Mr. Kraus by taking quick and decisive action to ensure the safety of Providence residents exemplify the very best qualities that the City has to offer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council hereby awards Providence Parks Department employees David Doti and Gary Kraus with the Municipal Medal of Bravery for risking their lives for the safety of others.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, upon passage, copies of this resolution will be sent to the Mayor of Providence, the Superintendent of Parks, David Doti, and Gary Kraus.
