

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved September 22, 1977

WHEREAS, William M. Thompson, a Member of the Tactical Bureau of the Providence Police Department, was promoted to the Rank of Sergeant, effective September 4, 1977, and

WHEREAS, in announcing the said promotion, Colonel Robert E. Ricci, Chief of the Police Department, on behalf of Commissioner of Public Safety, Leo P. Trambukis, reported that Sergeant Thompson has been the recipient of numerous commendations for noted Police work and devotion to his sworn duty, such as having been cited in 1970 for heroism in participating in the rescue of twenty-five persons from burning building on Washington Street and Service Road, and

WHEREAS, as a Bachelor of Science Degree in Law Enforcement from Bryant College, Sergeant Thompson is currently enrolled at Bryant College as a Candidate for a Masters Degree in Public Service in anticipation of his planned attendance as a Law Student, and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Thompson, in the service of his Country in the United States Army, served in the Korean and Viet Nam Conflicts, from which he has received an Honorable Discharge,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in expressing the congratulations of the City Council to Sergeant William M. Thompson of the Tactical Bureau of the Providence Police Department, the said Council further extends to him, its best wishes on his Law Enforcement career, education, and married life with his wife, Eileen and their two sons, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the adoption by the City Council and the approval by His Honor the Mayor of this Resolution, the City Clerk is directed to cause a duly engrossed copy of the same to be transmitted to Sergeant William M. Thompson of the Providence Police Department.
