ELECTION OF PRESIDENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL

ACTING COUNCIL PRESIDENT STRAVATO calls for nomination for the Office of President of the City Council for the remainder of the term ending on the First Monday in January, 1987.

COUNCILMAN O'CONNOR nominates COUNCILMAN NICHOLAS W. EASTON and this nomination is seconded by COUNCILMAN DILLON.

COUNCILWOMAN DiRUZZO nominates ACTING COUNCIL PRESIDENT LOUIS R. STRAVATO and this nomination is seconded by COUNCILWOMAN FARGNOLI.

ACTING COUNCIL PRESIDENT STRAVATO calls for further nominations and there are none.

There being no further nominations, on motion of COUNCILMAN GLAVIN, seconded by COUNCILMAN O'CONNOR, it is voted that nominations be closed and the Clerk is directed to call the Roll.

The Clerk calls and records the following votes:

For ACTING COUNCIL PRESIDENT STRAVATO: Acting Council President Stravato, Councilmen Annaldo, Cola, Councilwomen DiRuzzo, Fargnoli, Councilmen Griffin and Petrosinelli - 7.

For COUNCILMAN EASTON: Councilwoman Brassil, Councilmen Dillon, Easton, Farmer, Glavin, O'Connor and Pitts - 7.

ACTING COUNCIL PRESIDENT STRAVATO declares that as Section 405 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980 states - the affirmative votes of a majority of the entire City Council is required for the election of the President and eight votes being necessary, the Election of a Council President fails.
