

Re: One Way Street During School Transportation Hours - Reservoir and Ardoene

Dear Mr. Allen,

On behalf of the Reservoir Elementary School PTO, I am writing to request that a petition be filed on our behalf to implement a one way street usage running east to west on Ardoene Street. The hours of designation would be Monday through Friday from 8:00 - 9:30 a.m. and 2:00 - 3:30 p.m.

The PTO is requesting this change for several reasons, but safety as the primary motivation. During the next several months, the school will be opening a satellite site in the basement of the Nazarene Church located across the street from the school (Ardoene and Reservoir). In this space will be a family learning center, pre-school classroom instruction, and before school child care activities. Because the buses utilize the Ardoene Street entrance/exit (necessitated by the school's design which make this entrance/exit the most pragmatic), the concern is that the amount of traffic presently necessitated by the K-6 population coupled with the addition of 50-100 new families with very young children (3-5) using this area to arrive/depart at the same time is a potentially hazardous issue.

It is our understanding that similar designations exist at other locations. It would seem a prudent decision, given the amount of traffic on Reservoir Avenue and the increase in traffic which will accompany this expansion, to implement a proactive initiative to safeguard the children be supported.
