Approved January 4, 1991

RESOLVED, That permission is hereby granted to Harold Home Outfitters, Inc., 1 Central Street, Providence, Rhode Island, to use the air rights over Rice Street to connect two buildings with a pedestrian bridge approximately 9' - 0" wide and 25 feet 6 inches (low point) above the Rice Street elevation, in accordance with plans approved by the Director of the Department of Inspection and Standards, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Harold Home Outfitters, Inc., its successors and assigns, shall maintain with the City of Providence as an additional name insured, a policy of insurance in an amount of not less than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) the form of which shall be satisfactory to the City Solicitor, and

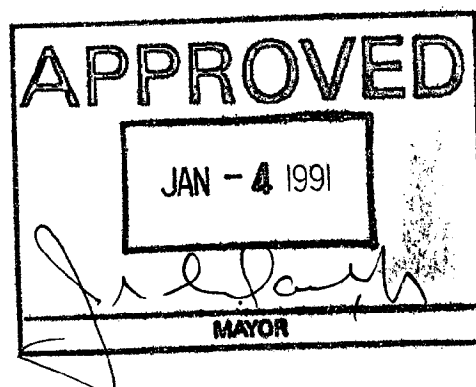


Dear Ms. Mendonca:
