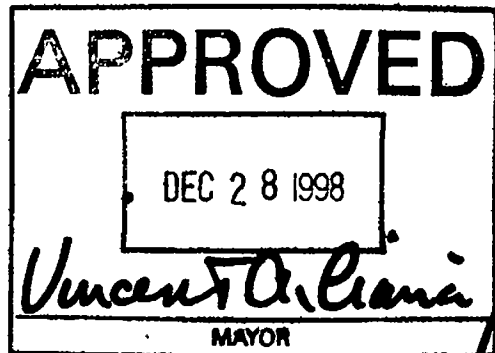

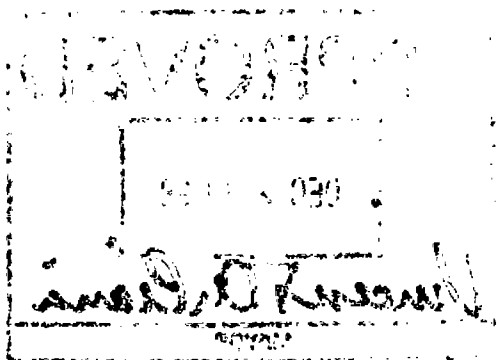


Dear Councilman Clarkin:

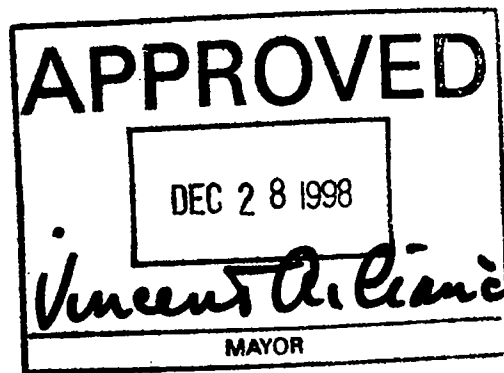

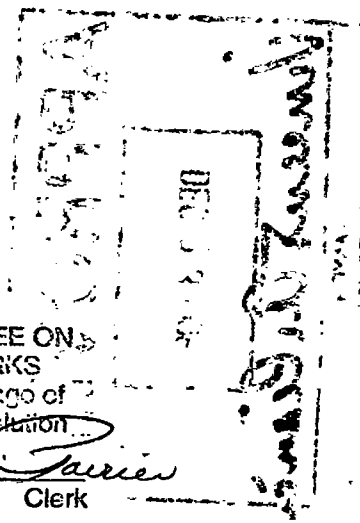
