

Annual report from the Providence Board of Canvassers for the
year January 1, 1980 through December 31, 1980.

1. New registrations taken in 1980	=	11,483
2. Transfers from other districts	=	3,455
3. Transfers to other districts	=	3,433
4. Voters removed because of deaths	=	1,157
5. Voters moved out of city and/or no vote 5 years	=	10,240
6. Eligible vote January 1, 1980	=	89,727
7. Eligible vote December 31, 1980	=	89,011

1980 was an extremely busy year for the Providence Board of Canvassers. In addition to the thousands of additions and deletions to the voting list as specified above, 1980 was a general election year for state candidates as well as a presidential election year.

This board conducted a special referenda election on March 28, 1980 for port and sewage bond issues, after having removed 6,474 voters from the list for no-vote 5 years in January.

We then conducted the presidential preference primaries for both parties as well as the elections for delegates to the presidential conventions on June 3, 1980. This was followed immediately by another special election on July 22, 1980 for 7 state referenda questions.

It must be remembered that every election held in 1980 was a city-wide election encompassing all 13 wards of the City of Providence.

September 9, 1980 was next with party primaries for State Offices and legislative seats as well as district committees, followed by the general election on November 4, 1980 for all Federal and State contests.

During the three months of August, September and October 1980, this board processed over 11,000 registrations and approximately 6,000 mail ballots.
