Report on Petition of Domenic Tagliatela, 159 Hudson Street, et, als, requesting a Public Hearing before the Providence City Council, to hear the citizens testimony on the effectiveness of the Providence Police Security.

HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Your Committee, to which was referred the above noted Petition, respectfully reports that it conducted a Public Hearing, on the said Petition, on Monday, November 3, 1975 at 7:00 o'clock P.M. (E.S.T.) in City Hall, Providence.

Attending that meeting was Councilman Addison, Councilmen Ahern, Henries, Merola and Bradshaw.

By invitation, Colonel Walter A. McQueeney, Chief of Police, was present.

Discussion ensued relative to receipt of electronic messages and the travel of such messages to its completion.

The area of Foot Patrolmen was discussed. Colonel McQueeney reported that due to budgetary problems no additional Foot Patrolmen could be deployed, nor could mobile units, presently inactive because of needed mechanically repairs, be utilized.

In response to Councilman Henries, Chief McQueeney reported he deploys Police Patrols according to the latest crime rate report he obtains.

In summation, the Chief reported that the present strength of the Police Department is 315, down from 350, which speaks for itself, however he conceded the assignment of one patrolman in the area of Prairie Avenue and Public Street.
