The City Council proceeds to elect the Judge of the Probate Court in Accordance with the Provisions of Section XI of Chapter 3340 of the Public Laws of 1954, Approved April 26, 1954, entitled, "An Act in Amendment of Clause I of Section XI of Chapter 598 of the Public Laws, 1866 as Amended, Relating to the Probate Court of the City of Providence."

ANTHONY B. SCIARRETTA, ESQUIRE, only nominee, was nominated to succeed himself for the term of Six (6) Years ending on the first Thursday in November, 1989, at the regular meeting of the City Council held on THURSDAY, OCTOBER 6, 1983, which date has allowed for the elapsed time of twenty days between the nomination and the election of the Judge of Probate Court.




