

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 384

Approved June 9, 1995

WHEREAS, The Providence City Council does hereby create a study commission of the City Council for the enforcement of the Residency Requirements as set forth by the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980 and the voters of the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the said commission is to track, monitor that Section (1210) of the Home Rule Charter, which states Residence requirement; exemptions; and,

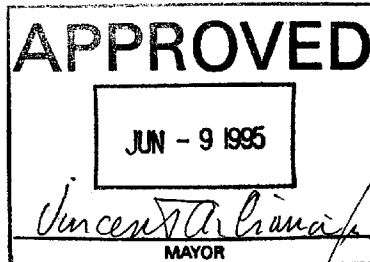
WHEREAS, The City Council believes that tracking and monitoring the residency rule would be in the best interest of the City, and,

WHEREAS, The Commission shall consist of seven (7) members, three (3) of whom shall be City Council Members, appointed by the City Council President, one (1) of whom shall be the Director of Personnel or his or her designee, one (1) of whom shall be the City Solicitor or his or her designee, one (1) of whom shall be a member of a bargaining unit within the City of Providence, appointed by the City Council President, and one (1) of whom shall be the Chairperson of the Providence Review Commission or his or her designee to be appointed by the City Council President.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Study Commission on Residency shall be created and shall respond to the City Council no later than September 1, 1995.
