SECTION 1. Chapter 1565 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 24, 1963, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$44,468,244.36 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1964", as amended, is hereby further amended by transferring the sum of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000) Dollars to HIGHWAY SECTION, ITEM 2.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000) Dollars shall be obtained by transferring a like amount from Sewer Construction & Maintenance Section, Item 0.
