RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED,

That Parsonage Street from the range of the southerly line of Lake Street southerly to Marengo Street and Marengo Street from Parsonage Street easterly one hundred seventy and eighty-three one hundredths (170.83) feet, shown as shaded area and designated by the letters A-B-C-D-E-F on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, R. I., P. W. Dept.-Engineering Office, City Property Section, Plan No. 062940, Date February 28, 1966" has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded and it is further

Stipulated that the abandoned portions of Marengo and Parsonage Streets be subject to a perpetual right and easement to be granted to the City of Providence by any and all persons who may acquire ownership of the above described area by virtue of the aforesaid proposed abandonment for the purpose of maintaining, operating or rebuilding a sewer within, across, through and upon the above described premises together with the right of the City of Providence by its agents, servants, officers and employees to enter said premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of repairing, rebuilding, and operating a sewer with such tools and other equipment as may be necessary and provided further that it is expressly understood and agreed that no structure shall be placed over or upon said easement or the land over or upon said easement be used so as to endanger the sewer in any way, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on Parsonage Street from the range of the southerly line of Lake Street southerly to Marengo Street and Marengo Street from Parsonage Street easterly one hundred seventy and eighty three one hundredths (170.83) feet, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting Parsonage Street

PETITION FOR THE ABANDONMENT OF PORTIONS
OF MARENGO AND PARSONAGE STREETS

WARD FOODS, INC., a New York corporation having a place of business in the City and County of Providence, State of Rhode Island, respectfully represents:

FIRST: That your petitioner together with Gerard M. and Aileen K. Dunn of Warwick, Rhode Island, are the owners in fee of all of the land bordering Marengo Street (westerly of Eddy Street) and that portion of Parsonage Street lying southerly of Lake Street. Said bordering land is laid out and designated as Lots No. 314, 315, 316, 334 and 396 on Providence Tax Assessor's Plat 21 and Lots No. 140 and 144 on Providence Tax Assessor's Plat 22.

SECOND: That your petitioner is the owner in fee of Lots No. 314, 315, 316 and 334 on said Tax Assessor's Plat 22.

THIRD: That said Gerard M. Dunn is the owner of Lot No. 140 on Tax Assessor's Plat 22, which parcel bordering on that street he has agreed to sell to your petitioner pursuant to a binding purchase and sale agreement.







Dear Councilman Payne:

Under date of December 20, 1965, we received an official memorandum from the Department of the City Clerk in regard to the petition from Ward Foods, Inc. requesting the abandonment of a portion of Marengo and Parsonage Streets. We have reviewed our distribution plans and find there is a 6" cast iron main in Parsonage and Marengo Streets that has a depreciated value of \$1,603.63. There is also a 3/4" service located within this section that has a depreciated value of \$63.80. The total depreciated value of all our facilities within this section requested for abandonment is \$1,667.43.

This department is filing a bill in the City Collector's Office against Ward Foods, Inc. covering the value of our facilities and request your consideration in withholding final action on this matter until the bill lodged in the City Collector's Office is paid.

Our planning office has examined the subject petition now being considered by the Committee on Public Works, which was referred to us because the location involved is within Redevelopment Area D-2.

This portion of area D-2 is outside the Federal Hill - South Providence General Neighborhood Renewal Plan Area, and thus is not slated for formal renewal action in the foreseeable future. We understand the City Plan Commission is making a careful review of the planning considerations relating to the abandonment petition, and are aware of any possible problems which may arise from the dead ending of Marengo Street a couple of hundred feet west of Eddy Street.

On the basis strictly of potential activities under our urban renewal program, we see no reason to object to the granting of this petition. We, therefore, would choose to defer our judgement in favor of whatever recommendation the Committee on Public Works may receive from the City Plan Commission in this instance.

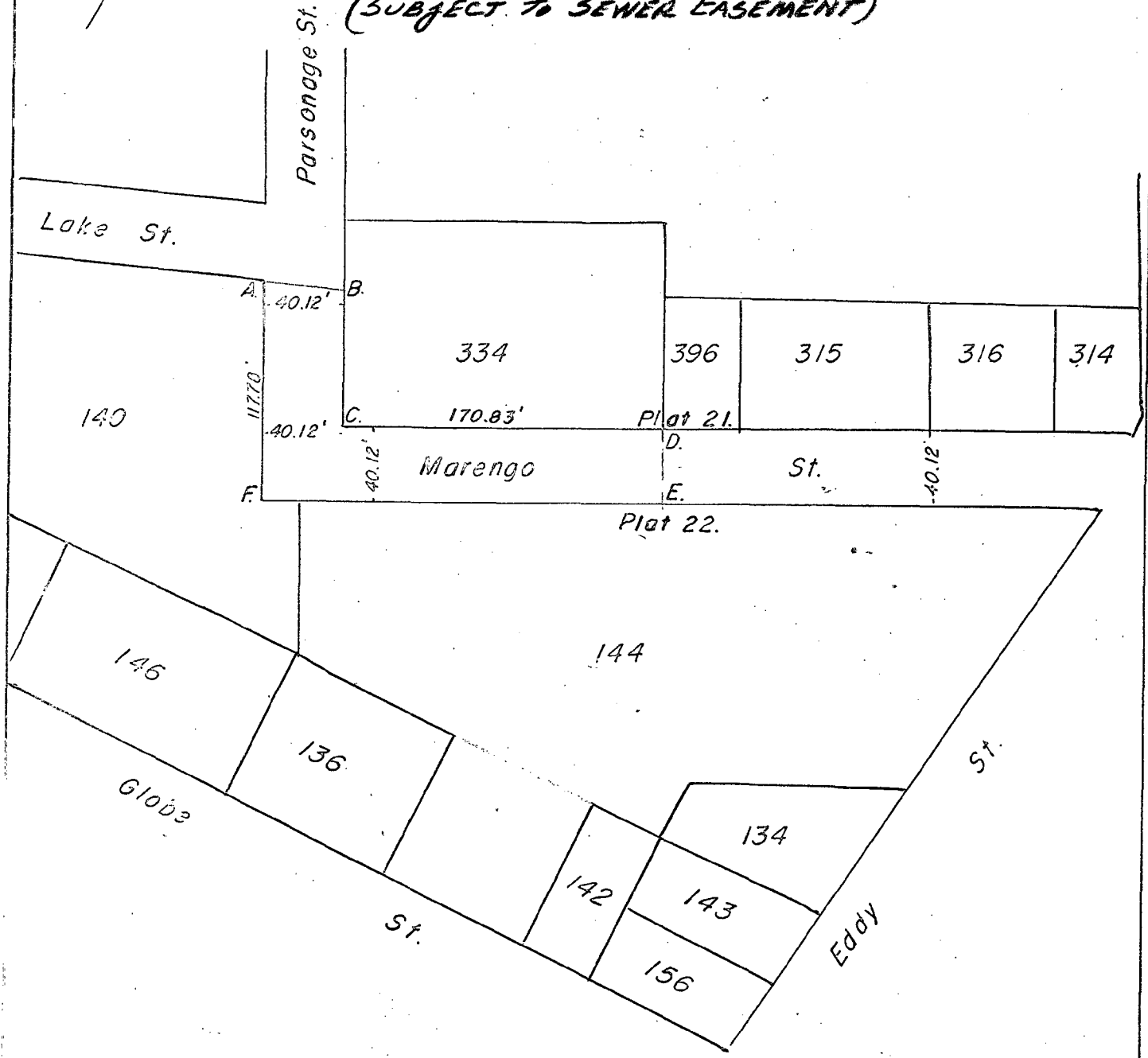

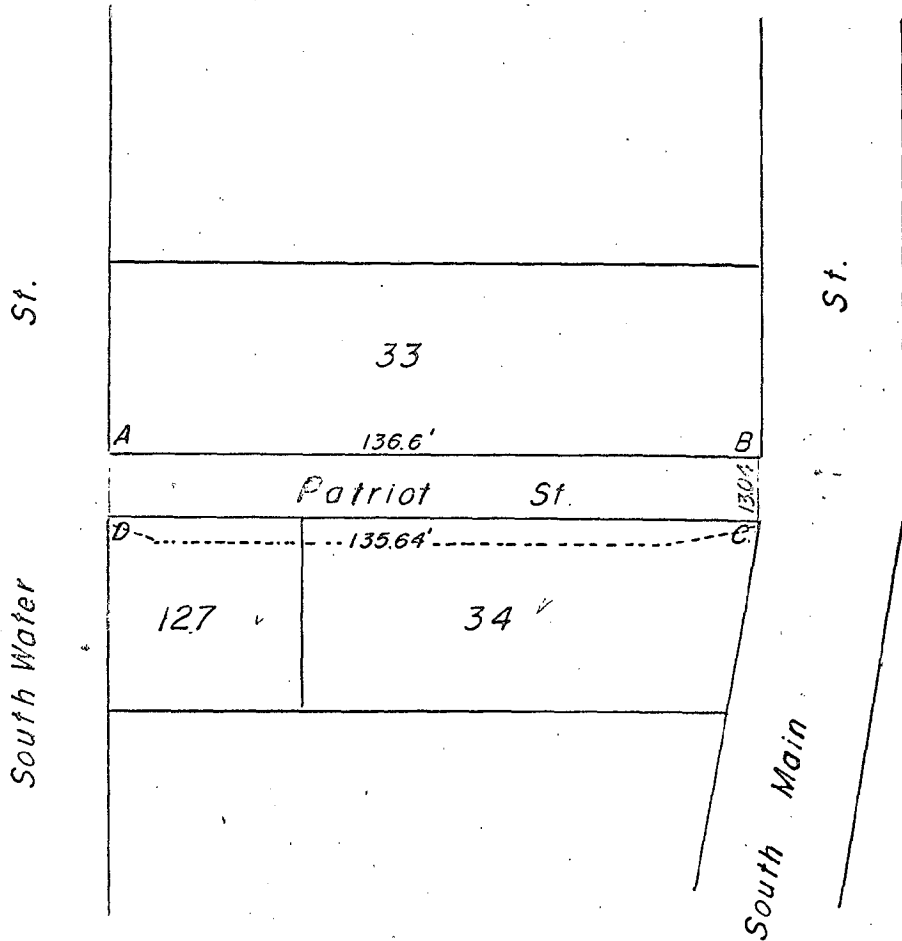
