




As the Director of Beneficent House at One Chestnut St. and on behalf of the tenants in 180 apartments I respectfully request your assistance in a matter which could seriously affect the safety of persons crossing Chestnut Street at night.

The light on pole #1 on Chestnut Street, the first pole in from Weybosset Street, is an older style and does not provide much illumination. If at all possible we would appreciate an upgrading to equal the lumens of other street lights in the area.

The fact that Johnson and Wales College has a substantial student body in the immediate area and many students travel this street during the hours of darkness makes good street lighting a very significant safety factor. Also, cars crossing from Empire to Chestnut Street have a tendency to enter Chestnut at a fairly high rate of speed making this area even more treacherous.
