



# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved January 8, 1954

Resolved,

That His Honor, Mayor Walter H. Reynolds, be and he hereby is authorized to execute a lease to the Jewish Community Center of Providence at a nominal rental of one (\$1.00) dollar per year covering a certain tract of land with building and improvements thereon situated on the southwesterly corner of Potters Avenue and Hamilton Street in the City of Providence containing approximately thirteen thousand, one hundred seventy (13,170) square feet of land and designated as Lot 196 on Assessor's Plat 49, said premises having been formerly used as a police station; said lease to be for a five-year period with options for renewal for two additional five-year periods; and to contain the stipulation that the lessee shall maintain and keep in repair the grounds and buildings, and such other terms and conditions as may be deemed advisable by the Mayor and the City Solicitor.

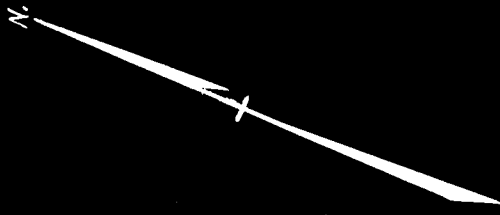
