### *Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

1. That Chapter 68-11 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, entitled "An Ordinance approving and adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Mount Hope Project No. R.I. R-18" as heretofore amended, be and is hereby further amended as follows:

    - c. Cypress Street Playground
    - d. Padelford Street Walkway
    - e. Pleasant Street Park
    - f. Jenkins Street Elementary School
  - B. Map - Delete certain Map No. 2 entitled "Proposed Land Use and Zoning" dated May 18, 1972 at page 36;

It is respectfully requested that this matter be introduced to the City Council at its April 24, 1973 meeting.


