RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 388

Approved July 20, 2012

WHEREAS, Effective July 11, 2011, the City Council and Mayor approved Resolution No. 384 Requesting the Zoning Board of Review Impose a Moratorium on Accepting and Hearing Applications for Full Entertainment Licenses in the Thirteenth Ward until December 31, 2011, or until such time that the Zoning Code is amended to address the concerns detailed in said resolution; and

WHEREAS, Effective March 22, 2012, the City Council and Mayor approved Resolution No. 155 to extend said moratorium until May 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, An ordinance amending the Zoning Code to address the concerns regarding entertainment licenses in the City of Providence was introduced and will be considered and deliberated upon by the City Council during the next two months; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that a moratorium continue to be imposed, for the reasons detailed in Resolution No. 384, until an amendment to the Zoning Code is approved by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence does hereby extend the moratorium on the acceptance of new applications to the Zoning Board for full entertainment licenses in Ward Thirteen, and the hearing and granting of pending applications before the Zoning Board for full entertainment licenses in Ward Thirteen; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That such moratorium shall be in effect upon approval of this resolution, through October 31, 2012, or until such time that the Zoning Code is amended to address the concerns detailed in this resolution and in Resolution No. 384; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon approval, a copy of this ordinance be sent to the Chair of the Zoning Board of Review.
