





A G R E E M E N T

WHEREAS, by an act entitled "An Act in amendment of and in addition to Chapter 1443 of the Public Laws of 1929" passed at the January Session of the General Assembly, A. D. 1931, and numbered Chapter 1779, said General Assembly authorized and empowered cities and towns owning ratable property devoted to public use located within any other city or town, to enter into an agreement fixing, for a period not exceeding five years at any one time, the amount and value of such property for the purpose of taxation; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed for the best interest of both the City of Providence and the Town of Johnston that an agreement be entered into under the authority contained in said act;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto:

That the valuation of the ratable property owned by the City of Providence in the Town of Johnston, and devoted to public use, on December 31, 1956 and on December 31st in each year succeeding that date to and including December 31, 1960, be and the same is hereby fixed at \$331,000.00 provided, however, that if the City of Providence should acquire additional ratable property in said Town of Johnston during the period provided for by this agreement either by purchase, condemnation or otherwise, and provided said additional ratable property is not exempt from taxation by said Town of Johnston, or if any ratable property located in said Town of Johnston belonging to the City of Providence on December 31, 1956 shall thereafter during said years be sold, destroyed, removed or otherwise disposed of, the Tax Assessors of said Town of Johnston shall make an equitable increase or decrease of the aforesaid valuation.

as the case may be, as to said ratable property. Should the City of Providence during the five year period aforesaid purchase or otherwise obtain additional ratable property in said Town of Johnston, or should said City of Providence sell or otherwise dispose of any of its ratable property in said Town of Johnston during said five year period, said City of Providence shall, in the period provided by the Tax Assessors of the Town of Johnston, as required by law for the filing of returns and sworn statements of ratable property, occurring next after such acquisition, sale or disposition of property as aforesaid, file with the Tax Assessors of said Town of Johnston a return or sworn statement setting forth the fair cash value or market value of ratable property acquired or disposed of by it since the date of the last annual assessment by the Tax Assessors of said Town of Johnston and said return or sworn statement, to be filed as aforesaid, need not include any statement as to the value of other ratable property owned by the City of Providence in said Town of Johnston and the City of Providence shall not otherwise be required, during the period provided for in this agreement, to make an annual return or sworn statement of the value of its ratable property located in said Town of Johnston.

It is further agreed that in making said assessment the Tax Assessors of the Town of Johnston shall not be required to list each parcel separately nor shall they be required to list land, buildings, improvements and tangible personal property in separate columns.

Except as otherwise provided, the Town of Johnston hereby agrees not to carry on its assessment rolls during said period any sum other than the amount above stated.
