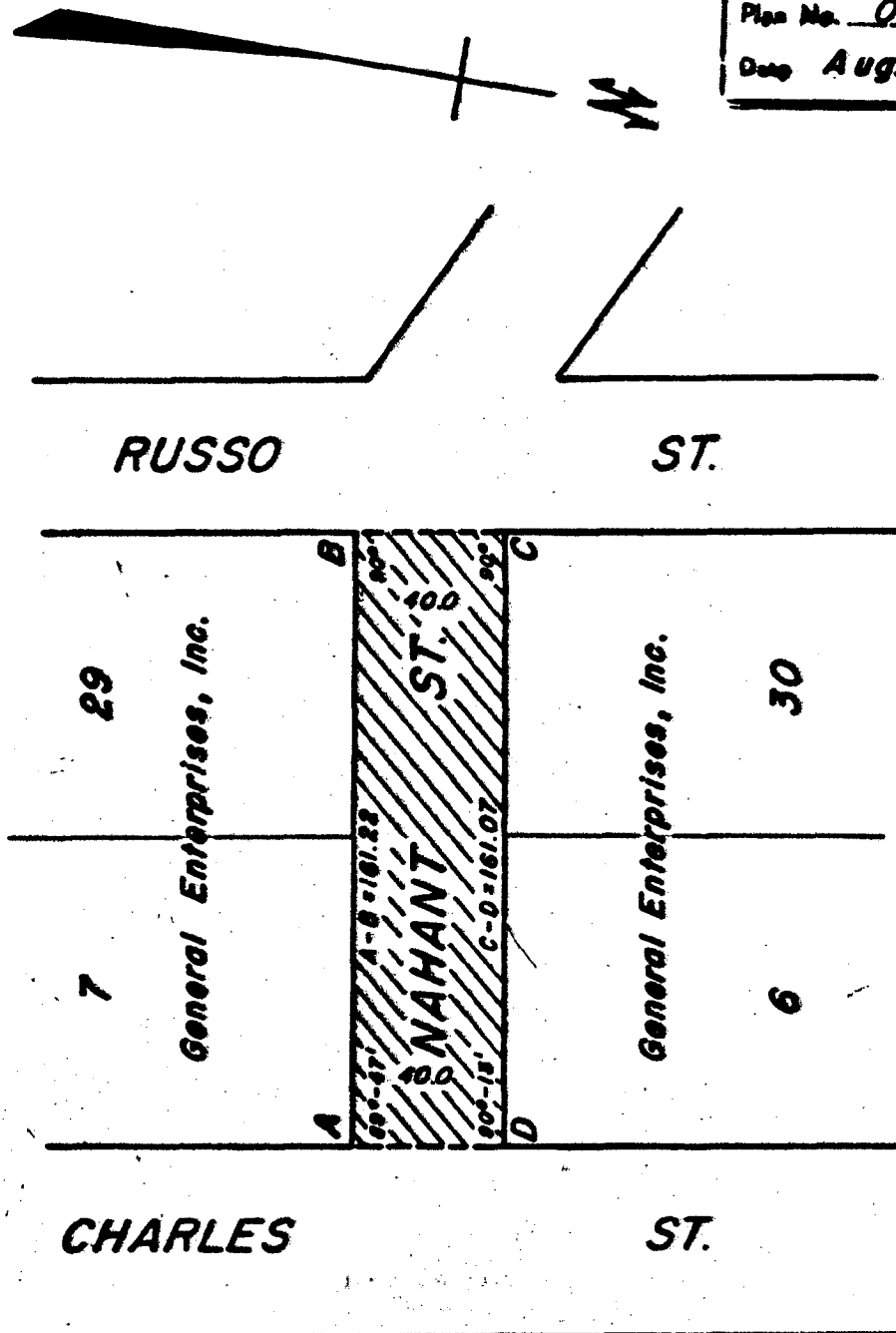

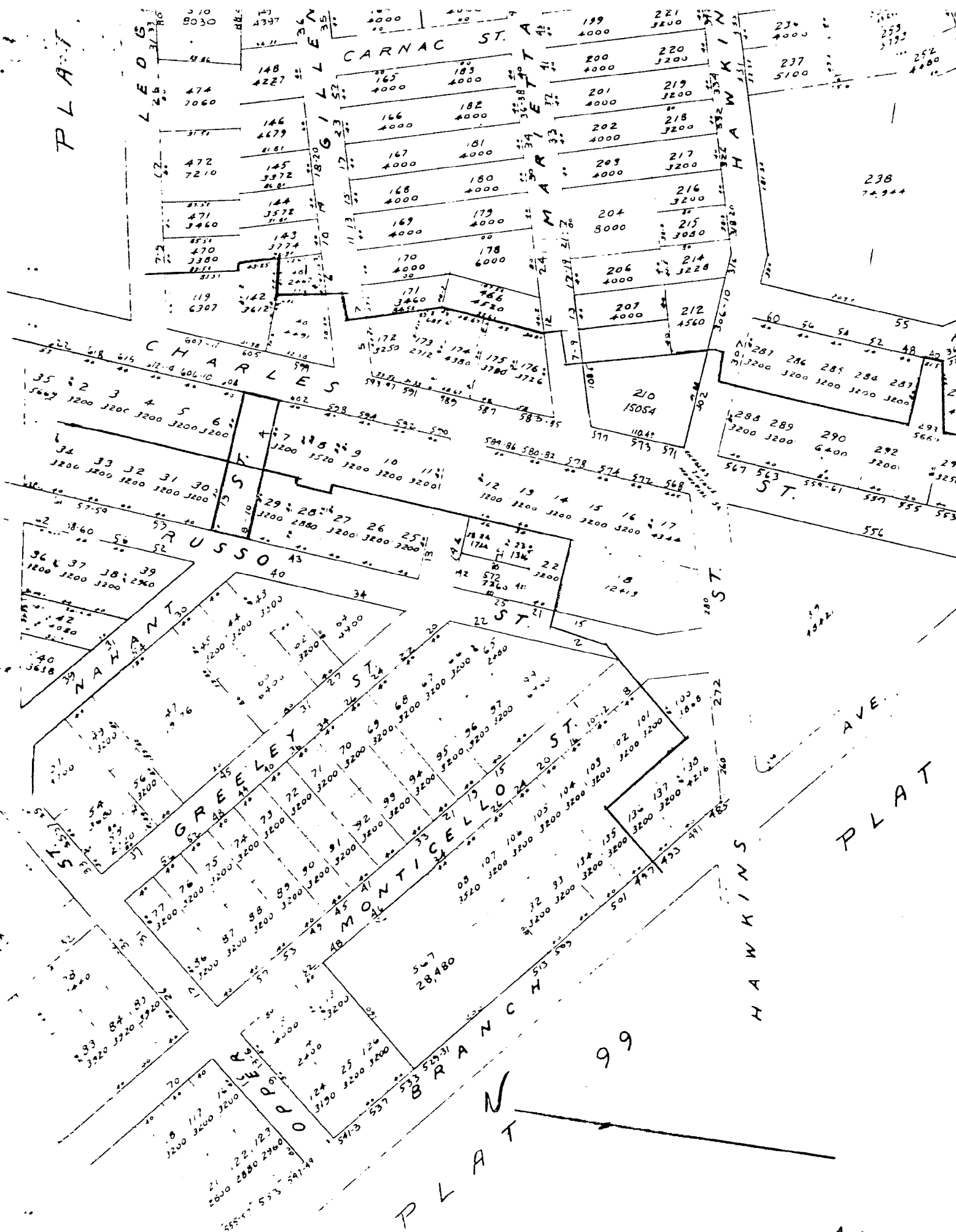



Gentlemen:

The subject referral was to be presented to the City Plan Commission at the June 3, 1981 monthly meeting, which was cancelled when it appeared that a quorum could not be assembled. However, this Department reviewed the referral; field checked the information contained therein, and reports as follows:

A field inspection revealed that subject portion of Nahant Street is a 40' wide improved public right-of-way with sidewalks and curbs. Said portion abutts a parking lot at each side. These parking lots are improved, well maintained and are owned by the petitioner to serve his business across Charles Street (Fain's Department Store). There are residential and commercial structures within the surrounding area in fair exterior condition. The subject portion and its surrounding area are located within the R-2 Two-Family Zone and C-2 General Commercial Zone.

It appears that the portion of Nahant Street in question generates a very small amount of vehicular traffic. It has no important value as a public thoroughfare, but is a service road to the adjoining parking lots, and it is also located within the Charles Street Renewal Project and this proposal is in keeping with the Urban Renewal Plan of the renewal project. This department has no objection to this petition.

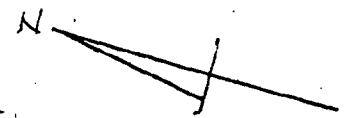
Enclosed with this letter for your information file are maps and copies of photographs of the area in question. My staff and I are available at your pleasure to review the petition with the Committee members.

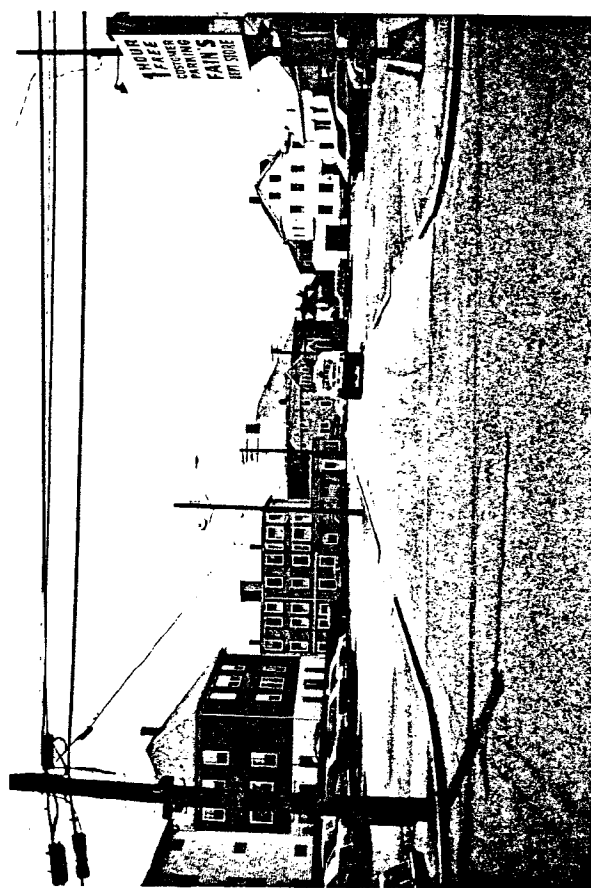
VIEW OF SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF NAHANT & RUSSO STS.

Gentlemen:

In response to a request for the abandonment of Nahant Street, from Charles Street to Russo Street, I have been advised by the Fire Department that such an abandonment would have an effect on its operations.

Charles, Russo and Greeley Streets are all heavily congested, with little or no off-street parking; and to abandon Nahant Street would only aggravate a present serious problem. The area has parking on both sides of the street and this creates a problem. This portion of Nahant Street is now used as a direct route to the rear of Monsignor Bove School; and alternate routes could prove difficult with a change in traffic flow.

Because of this, I would not recommend this abandonment.
