SECTION 6. The number of employees in the Office of Federal Programs shall not exceed three (3). There shall be no more than:

- 1.00 *Director of Federal Programs*
- 1.00 *Communication Specialist¹*
- 1.00 *No Child Left Behind Compliance Officer*

SECTION 34. The number of employees in the Office of Academics shall not exceed seven (7). There shall be no more than:

- 1.00 *Chief Academic Officer*
- 1.00 *Director of Teaching and Learning*
- 1.00 *Director of Career and Technical Education*
- 1.00 *Executive Director of School Transformation¹*
- 1.00 *Director of School Improvement*
- 2.00 Clerks

SECTION 41. The number of employees in the Office of Research and Assessment shall not exceed six (6). There shall be no more than:

- 1.00 *Director of Research, Planning & Accountability*
- 1.00 *Assessment Specialist for Adequate Yearly Progress*
- 1.00 *Data Media Specialist*
- 1.00 *Data Analyst / Statistician¹*
- 1.00 Facilitator of District Reform
- 1.00 Clerk
