RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved

WHEREAS, it appears that adequate funds have not been voted by the City Council in the amended 1975-1976 Budget and as a result, it may be necessary to curtail the employment of approximately three hundred to four hundred City employees, and

WHEREAS, in order to curtail the prospective termination of said employees, funds must be made available and provided, in lieu of the inadequate fiscal program recently adopted by the City Council, and

WHEREAS, it appears there are unexpended balances available which can be transferred on a monthly basis, so that wage increases, submitted by the Mayor in his 1975-1976 Budget payable beginning July 1, 1975, could insure these benefits to all City employees, making it unnecessary to layoff any City employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby authorize the transfer of all unexpended balances, on a month to month basis, so that the wage increases of all City employees can be effected and further that there will be no curtailment of certain City employees.
