NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Morris Avenue Extension, from Olney Street to Alumni Avenue is hereby made a One-Way Street with traffic permitted to travel South to North only during the following hours: Monday through Friday, from 7:45 o'clock A.M. to 8:30 o'clock A.M.; Monday Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 2:45 o'clock P.M. to 3:30 o'clock P.M.; and Wednesday from 12:00 o'clock M. to 12:30 o'clock P.M.
