# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved October 27, 1978

WHEREAS, Peat, Marwick, Mitchell and Co., Auditors of the City of Providence, have submitted a tentative report that the City has incurred a One Million, Two Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollar Deficit for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1978, being the third deficit during the past three years, and

WHEREAS, The said Auditors' report has showed that the Department of Public Works has overspent its Budget for that fiscal year,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the firm of Peat, Marwick, Mitchell and Co., are hereby requested to analyze the reasons for the deficit and to submit to the City Council, a detailed analysis, as to the number of employees in the Department of Public Works, their job classifications and all other pertinent data.
