

Dear Mr. Vespia:

In response to the resolution of January 10, 1966, which was submitted to this department, please be advised that we have made a thorough check of the street and sidewalk lighting under the parking deck on Francis Street and at the present time more than adequate lighting is installed under this parking deck to facilitate safe and rapid vehicular traffic, and pedestrian safety while waiting for buses on the sidewalk area.

However on checking the light circuits for the underpass, the Traffic Engineering Department, which maintains this equipment, found a faulty photo-electric unit which controls the on and off-timing of the sidewalk lights.

This has been repaired and all lights are now functioning on their specific design.
