I hereby disapprove and veto this Resolution. I feel I must veto the Resolution of the Providence City Council which seeks to create a Special Committee of the Council to study parking problems within the City. I must take this step insofar as the proposal would jeopardize a clear delegation of Authority to the Executive Branch of the municipal government.

Both the "Providence Public Parking Act" and Article IX of the Providence Code of Ordinances establish municipal agencies which are specifically empowered to oversee and delegate on and off street parking within the City. Both such agencies are extensions of the Executive. In light of this specific delegation of the parking authority to the Executive, the proposal must be vetoed.
