## CHAPTER 68-57

No. 294 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 67-A of CHAPTER 68-57, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 23, 1968, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS", RELATIVE TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 67-A of Chapter 68-57 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 23, 1968, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

SECTION 67-A: DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

Delete: Four (4) Laborer

Add: Four (4) Equipment Operator

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
