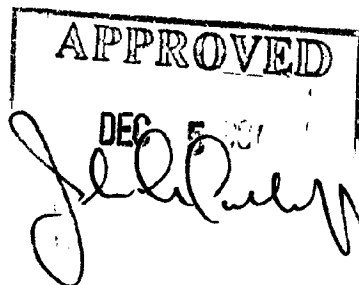

Dear Mr. President and Council Members:

In July of 1984, Mayor Paolino asked me to serve on a temporary basis in his new administration. I filled a specific position for approximately three months and then I removed myself from the payroll while continuing to serve him in numerous capacities. In June of 1985, I accepted a temporary position with the Providence Port Commission and served several months as Port Director.

In the summer of 1986, I was asked by the Mayor to assist this administration in the area of Economic Development and now I will be serving as an interim Executive Director of the Providence Civic Center.

It is apparent that the total time I will have spent in a position in Providence Government between Economic Development and the Civic Center will exceed six months.

Because of the temporary nature of the positions I have filled and the uncertainty of my continued service, I would respectfully request an exemption from the residency requirement of the City Charter.

Parenthetically, I have been very proud to have been able to serve you to date. Thank you in advance for your consideration.
