SUBJECT: Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to install "No Thru Traffic" signs on both ends of Modena Avenue.

The office of Traffic Engineering has investigated this request and would like to note that "No Thru Traffic Signs shall be used in locations to inform the driver that there is only one entrance to the street such as a dead end street. Modena Avenue is a thru street, therefore the requested signage is not recommended.
