It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 37-8 of the General Laws entitled "Public Buildings" is hereby
2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 37-8-3.1. Hurricane Barrier Subsidy. -- The state of Rhode Island shall reimburse the
4 city of Providence in an amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) annually for
5 the costs of repairs and capital improvements to the Fox Point Hurricane Barrier of the city of
6 Providence.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
