That Mary Street from Borden Street to Lockwood Street, shown as shaded area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R.I., P.W. Dept.--Engineering Office, City Property Section, Plan No. 062089, Date September 1, 1960", has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Superintendent of Street Signs and Numbers be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on Mary Street from Borden Street to Lockwood Street, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

PETITION FOR ABANDONMENT OF MARY STREET

Rhode Island Hospital, a corporation organized by the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island, and having its principal place of business in the City of Providence, in said state, respectfully represents:

FIRST: That your petitioner is the owner in fee of all of the land bordering Mary Street on the west and a portion of the land bordering said Mary Street on the east, said Mary Street being a city street one block in length running between Borden Street and Lockwood Street in the City of Providence, which land is described as follows:

Lots Numbered 28, 29, and 63,
Providence Assessor's Plat No. 22

SECOND: Your petitioner is informed that Tower Realty Co. is the owner of all of the remaining land bordering said Mary Street on the east not owned by your petitioner and that Tower Realty Co. is prepared to execute and deliver to the City of Providence a statement in writing joining in the prayers of this Petition and agreeing with said City that in the event that this Honorable City Council shall see fit to abandon Mary Street to waive any and all claims for damages arising out of said abandonment. 

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1171 - ABANDONMENT OF MARY STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, October 4, 1960.

This referral is a request to abandon Mary Street as a public highway from Borden Street to Lockwood Street.

It was determined on an inspection and photographic survey that the street in question was uncurbed and unpaved.

Since it is a fact that the four corner parcels of land are abutting the block length of the street and have access on accepted City streets, it is unlikely that this street will be curbed or paved. Also, since the abandonment of this minor street will not conflict with any present or long-term City plans,




