ELECTION OF PROVIDENCE MUNICIPAL COURT JUSTICE

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for nominations for Chief Judge of the Providence Municipal Court and COUNCILMAN KELLY nominates SANFORD H. GORODETSKY, ESQUIRE, of Providence; this nomination is seconded by COUNCILMAN ADDISON.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for further nominations.

COUNCILMAN PEARLMAN nominates LOUIS J. COSENTINO, ESQUIRE, of Providence, and this nomination is seconded by COUNCILMAN BRADSHAW.


COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for further nominations and there are none.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for a Standing Vote.

The Clerk counts those Standing and Voting for LOUIS J. COSENTINO, ESQUIRE, being two in number.
