WHEREAS, The Providence Water Supply Board comes under the jurisdiction of the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission, and



WHEREAS, The Chairman of the Public Utilities Commission has transmitted to the Members of the City Council his concern that the Water Supply Board and City have failed to comply with certain directives of the PUC,


WHEREAS, While the City Council believes that the City is entitled to a return on its investment in the Water Supply Board, and that certain of the PUC's rulings have burdened the taxpayers of Providence, the City Council also recognizes the need to comply with the lawful directives of the PUC and has created a Special Commission to work with the PUC staff to foster improved communications between the City, the Water Supply Board, and the PUC

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chief Engineer of the Water Supply Board and the Director of Finance are directed to cause the creation and funding of separate interest bearing accounts as required by the Public Utilities Commission in Docket number 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Engineer of the Water Supply Board, and all other City and Water Supply Board Officials are directed to comply with the directives and information requests contained in the Public Utilities Commission "Report and order, State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations Public Utilities Commission, In re: Providence Water Supply Board Compliance, Docket Nos. 2022, 2044, 2048", which was transmitted to the members of the City Council via correspondence from Mr. Malachowski dated May 28, 1993.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, That the Water Supply Board shall cause copies or summaries of any future orders from the Public Utilities Commission to the Water Supply Board to be transmitted to the City Clerk for formal receipt by the City Council at its next regular meeting.
